

Transport Emergency Card (TREM Card)

"TREM Card" is short form of Transport Emergency Card.

Definition:

- It is a document which is used while transporting dangerous goods/Hazardous substances.
- TREM Card has important safety related information of hazardous substances/Dangerous goods.
- It gives clear picture about hazards, PPEs, Contact Details, Action in case of leakage, Spillage, Fire, First Aid with national and international numbers like UN number or signage.
- It also provides instructions to driver or emergency responder in case of any emergency.
- TREM card shall make available in multi-language for the purpose of easy to understand for driver and local public of transportation route.
- TREM Card must be visible all time in vehicle while transporting dangerous goods/Hazardous substances.
- Both Consignee and Consignor are responsible to ensure availability and enough information provision to operator according to hazardous substance.
- TREM card detail is mostly retrieve from MSDS of the material.

Emergency Action:	Immediately inform police and fire brigade.
	Move vehicle in open area and stop engine if possible to do so.
	No Smoking.
	Drive in marked lane only and warn road users.
	No naked flame.
	Keep public away from danger.
	Avoid direct metal to metal contacts.
	Use non sparking tools only if required.
	Avoid making sparks in any condition.
Spillage:	Cordon area immediately.
	Do not touch.
	Consult an Expert.
	Do not expose to heat or electricity.
	Reseal where necessary, but do not repack.
	Protect exposed material from accidental ignition.
Fire:	Quickly extinguish small fire with available suitable extinguisher of vehicle, before it reaches to material.
	In case of large fire, do not attempt to fire.
	Evacuate the area immediately and keep public away at safe distance.
First Aid:	Keep patient warm.
	Seek Immediate medical help.
	In case of burn immediately cool affected skin area with cold water as long as possible.
	Refer additional information provided by manufacturer or sender.
