
Emergency Action:	Immediately inform police and fire brigade.
	Move vehicle in open area and stop engine if possible to do so.
	No Smoking.
	No naked flame.
	Keep public away from danger.
	Avoid direct metal to metal contacts.
	Use non sparking tools only if required.
	Avoid making sparks in any condition.
Spillage:	Absorb in earth or sand and remove to a safe place.
	Subsequently flush with water.
	Consult an Expert.
	If substance mixed with water stream or contaminated land or vegetation, Advise police.
Fire:	Keep containers cool by spraying water over it if exposed to fire.
	Extinguish preferably with DCP, Alcohol Foam or water spray.
	Do not use halon.
First Aid:	Remove contaminated clothes immediately and wash affected skin, eyes with plenty of water.
	Seek medical treatment when any one has symptoms due to inhalation or contact with skin or eyes.
	Due to delayed effect of poisoning persons who have inhaled the fumes produced in a fire must lie down and keep quite still. Patient should be kept under medical observation for at least for 48 hours.
